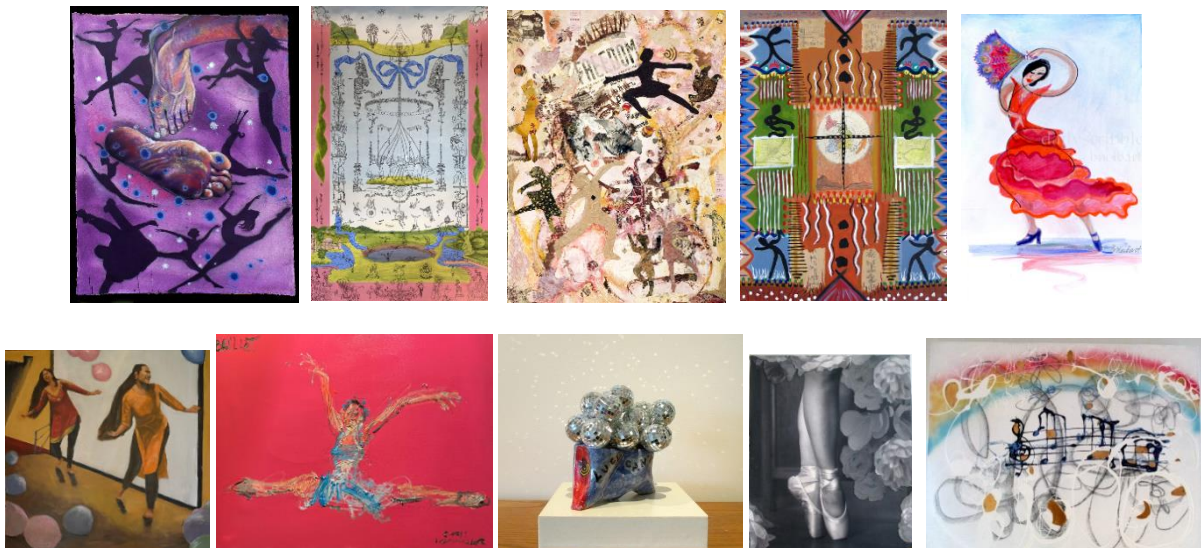

Move: Dance in Art I & II

For Fall 2022, member institutions in the Arts & Culture Collaborative, Morris County, have created a series of events and programs around the ancient and universal theme of dance. The Gallery 14 Maple at Morris Arts, and the Therese A. Maloney Art Gallery at Saint Elizabeth University, are presenting: **Move: Dance in Art I and II**, both separate exhibitions, but both building on the same theme.

Each of these shows highlights 2-D and 3-D visual works and, at the Maloney Art Gallery, video recordings, from New Jersey-related artists of various backgrounds and ages. All the works celebrate various eras and places while emphasizing each individual visual artist's unique viewpoints, styles, materials and interpretations. There are early Australian aboriginal rock art images and tribal figures and views of other traditional native dances from around the world. You will find a current-day ballet class, flamenco dancers, or collaged reminiscences of 1980s boom boxes and break dancing. Some works reveal participants flying through the air; other figures are serenely prancing in the street to their own beat. There are sweeping dance-like gestures in large abstract paintings as well as in the bronze sculptures. Delicate watercolors revealing a dancer and a musician, side by side, while the plastic and debris-filled vortex in *The Mid-Pacific Gyre* reminds us there are some destructive dances in nature that need to be stopped. The joy, the intensity, the solemnity and the excitement of dancing is one of the art forms that connects us all! Remember to Move, Dance and Celebrate with us this Fall!

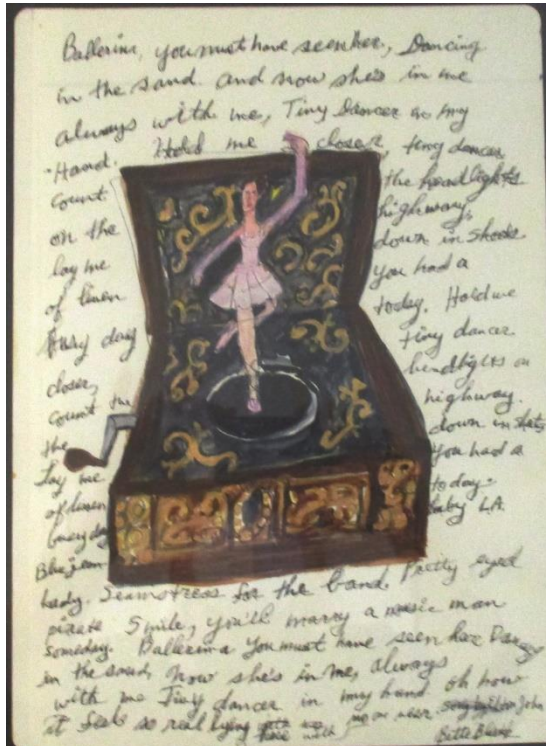

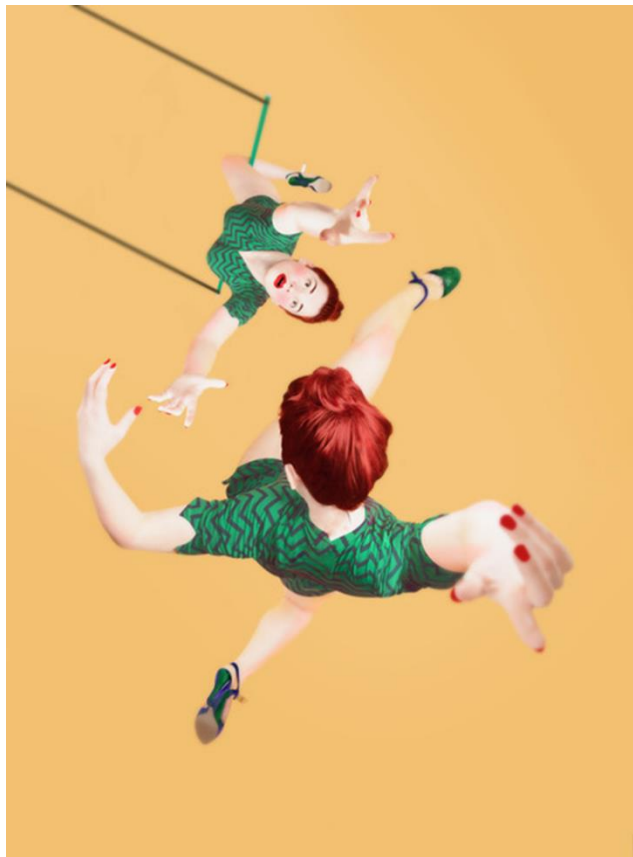
